

## Be a “Race Day Volunteer”

The Fisherman’s 5K Race Committee is in need of volunteers to help “lighten the load” on race day. We currently have openings at a variety of positions:

**Traffic Management** – Help keep runners “on course” and streets clear of traffic.

**Registration Table** – Greet participants as they arrive, help them sign in and distribute tee-shirts.

**Hospitality Table** – Distribute water and refreshments to runners. Check bags and coats.

**Mile Markers** – Take a position at Mile#1 or #2 and yell times to passing runners.

**Water Station** – Hand out water to runners at a designated spot on the course.

**Kids' Races** – Help organize the kids into their race groups,  
Get them to the starting line and  
Hand out medals as they finish.

As you can see, even if you’re not a runner (or a walker) there are still plenty of ways for you to become involved in this exciting event! The time commitment is short (just a few hours) and you’ll be doing a world of good for the students of St. Peter School.
