



TERRA NOVA TESTING IS THE WEEK OF MARCH 7TH, 2016

Dear Parents:

The theme for this year's Catholic Schools Week was "Communities of Faith, Knowledge and Service". We are continuing to promote this theme as we prepare for the annual Terra Nova Testing. All year long we have been presenting the students with test taking strategies and skills. With the Terra Nova Tests approaching, we are asking you to join us in our mission to prepare the students for a successful testing experience. The strategies and skills we have been demonstrating all year are life skills that prepare the students for all testing situations, including subject matter testing, placement testing and entrance exams (i.e. SAT, ACT). In addition to ensuring that your child has a healthy breakfast each morning and sufficient sleep (a minimum of 8 hours each night), we have prepared the following list of work/test taking strategies for you to review and utilize with your child at home.

- ✓ Check your work.
- ✓ Eliminate answers that are obviously incorrect.
- ✓ Be sure you are on the correct section, page and question before recording your answer.
- ✓ Read questions before reading the passage to establish a purpose for reading.
- ✓ Read all answer choices before selecting your answer.
- ✓ Don't spend too much time on one question.
- ✓ Answer all questions. Your best guess is always better than no answer.
- ✓ Be aware of key words in the questions (i.e. always, never, not, etc.)
- ✓ Only change your answer if you are sure your first choice is wrong.
- ✓ Read everything and read carefully.

We know that education and your child's success is as important to you as it is to us. We ask you to join us in making sure your child is prepared to "show what they know" each and every day as well as on the Terra Nova Tests this year. Please review the above work/test strategies with your child on a regular basis. Together we can help to ensure that these life skills become the good habits your child will need for future success.




