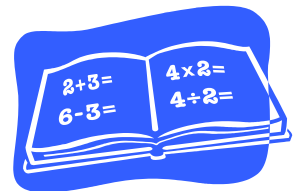

Dear Parents,

As we head in to the summer months, just a few friendly reminders to ensure the continuity of care and safety of all our students for the coming school year:

1. All students entering Grade 6 in September of 2016 are required to have a physical by their family physician. Forms will be sent home and we are requesting they be returned by September 1st.
2. All students entering Grade 6 are also required by law to have an additional Tdap if born after January 1, 1997 as well as a Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine. This also needs to be sent in by September 1, 2016
3. All students participating in sports for the 2016-2017 school year must have a current physical on file in the school health office **2 weeks prior to the start of practice**. You can download the physical and medical release form on the Saint Peter School website. Students who do not provide the proper documentation will not be eligible for participation in practice or games.
4. Please be sure to up-date your child's health record should any new conditions/allergies occur over the summer months.
5. If your child needs any medication, prescription or over the counter, please have the permission to medicate forms filled out by your physician and returned by the 1st day of school.

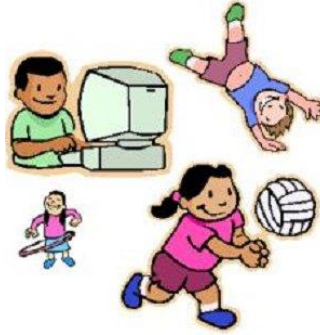
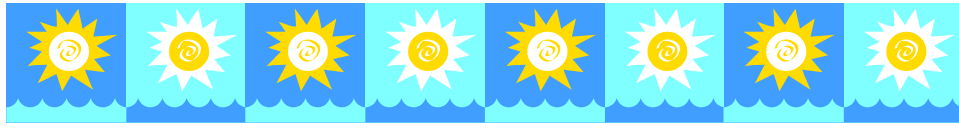
