

PRECAUTIONS FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR STUDENTS USING CAR LINE

MORNINGS

- 1. Pull up to the **Forman Avenue** curb, as close to the car ahead of you as possible.
- 2. Use car doors on the curb side of the car to exit your child.
- 3. Immediately get back into your car and move on so as not to create a jam.
- 4. DO NOT PARK at the curb...this creates potentially dangerous traffic jams.
- 5. Keep the line moving!!! Please!!!

If you must park for good reason:

Park along the gym or across the street after dropping-off your child(ren).

AFTERNOONS

- 6. Pull up to the **Forman Avenue** curb, as close to the car ahead of you as possible.
- 7. Park and meet your child at the door between Kolbe Hall and the school.
- 8. Wait for the teacher to acknowledge you before taking your child.

When parking in the school yard:

- 9. Arrive before 2:10 p.m.
- 10. Stay in proximity to your car.
- 11. After being identified by your child, get into your car with your child(ren).
- 12. <u>Do not drive</u> out of the parking lot <u>until all the children are in cars or returned to the school building</u>...waiting for a late pickup.

If you are in a hurry, parking on the street or along the gym is your best bet!

Saint Peter School Extended Care Program

EXTENDED CARE BEGINS ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 8TH.

Place: The Extended Care Program is held every day in Lower Kolbe Hall. On days of early dismissal, the program begins at 12:30. The program is held only on days when the school is in session.

Pick-Up: Use the Atlantic Avenue front door only. It will be locked. Knock on the door and the Director will let you in. Only persons noted on the registration form will be allowed to pick up the children (Emergency change - call school).

Registration: Think about registration if you haven't already. You never know! The information on the registration form is necessary for the Directors after school hours.

Health: The school nurse supplies the Directors with health records of the children (allergies, etc.)

Snack: Parents supply the snack. A time and place for the children to eat is provided. On days of Early Dismissal (12:30 pm), remember lunch will be needed.

Program: The daily program calls for time for the children to go to the park. Time/place for homework is also insured. There are many other activities for the children as well as time to enjoy the computer, etc. All activities both inside and out are supervised.

Payment: Depending on use, payment may be made on the day or weekly. We ask that payments never go beyond 2 weeks. Tax credit information will be given upon request.

Programs/Clubs/Choir/After School: Children may go to or from any program to Kolbe Hall. The extended care Directors/Teachers (Program Director) arrange for pick up/drop off for the Program.
