Grants: Saint Peter School has received a \$10,000 grant from Thrivent Financial, and we are currently in discussions to purchase the WeatherSTEM weather station. With WeatherSTEM, we will have our own customized weather station that will allow our students to connect their learning to the world around them, engage in STEM lessons, analyze data, and inform the local community. We also received a \$500 grant from Exxon Mobil to be used for science or math!

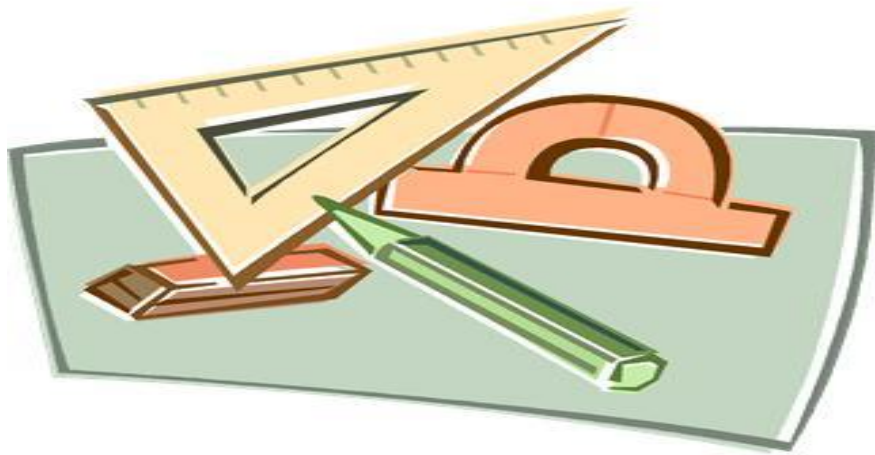

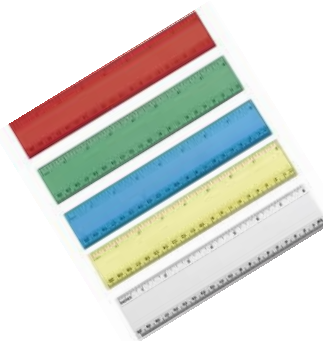
