Dear Saint Peter School Families,

As a non-public school, Saint Peter School has received state funding for school security under the *Secure Schools for All Children Act*. This funding is enabling us to significantly enhance our school security for the safety of our students - our number one priority.

We have installed a new door camera and intercom system to replace the one at the main entrance which enhances the office staff's ability to determine who is looking to enter the school. In addition, security cameras are being installed throughout the school. These cameras will <u>only</u> be placed in public areas, which includes hallways, cafeteria, gymnasium, lobby areas, and parking lot. Cameras will not be installed in any place where students, staff, or visitors may have a reasonable expectation of privacy, such as classrooms, offices, restrooms, or locker rooms. These cameras may be monitored at any time.

The use of video surveillance cameras can greatly improve the safety and security of our students, staff, and visitors by deterring outsiders from entering our campus for inappropriate purposes. These cameras may also deter students from engaging in inappropriate behavior while at school. The installation of surveillance cameras helps to create a safe, secure learning environment for everyone at Saint Peter School, and we are extremely pleased to have received this funding for such an important purpose.


