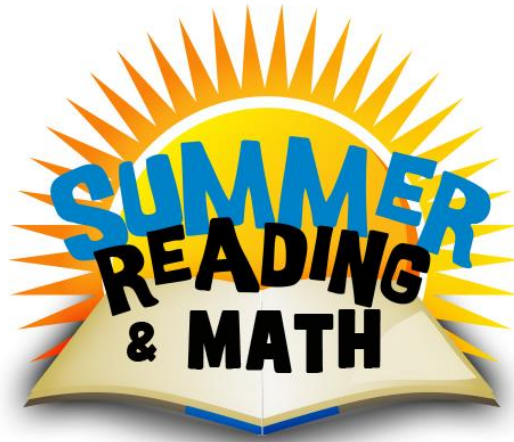

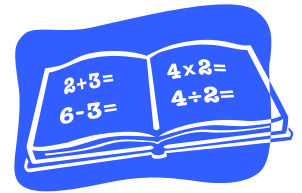

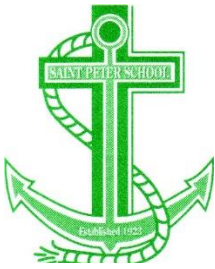

Dear Parents,

As we head into the summer months, just a few friendly reminders to ensure the continuity of care and safety of all our students for the coming school year:

1. All students entering Grade 6 in September of 2017 are required to have a physical by their family physician. Forms are available on the website and we are requesting they be returned by September 1<sup>st</sup>.
2. All students entering Grade 6 are also required by law to have an additional Tdap vaccination if born after January 1, 1997 as well as a Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine, given **NO EARLIER** than 10 years of age. This also needs to be sent in by September 1, 2017.
3. All students participating in sports for the 2017-2018 school year must have a current physical on file in the school health office **2 weeks prior to the start of practice**. You can download the physical and medical release form on the Saint Peter School website. Students who do not provide the proper documentation will not be eligible for participation in practice or games. Please send in the original physical form and keep a copy of it for your personal file.
4. Please be sure to up-date your child's health record should any new conditions/allergies occur over the summer months.
5. If your child needs any medication which includes prescription or over the counter, please have the permission to medicate forms filled out by your physician and returned by the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school.

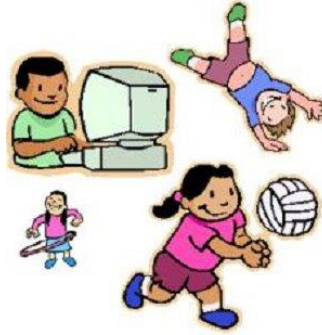
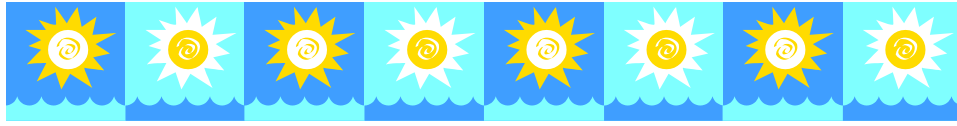
