

You are invited to Saint Peter's Annual Halloween Parade Wednesday, October 31st, 2018 From 1:00 p.m. to 1:45 p.m.

Children do not come to school in costume. They carry their costumes to school in a bag, and will return home the same way. Costumes are to be simple, no make-up. All students are permitted to wear gym uniforms on that day. The children will put their costumes on over their gym uniform in the classroom. 




