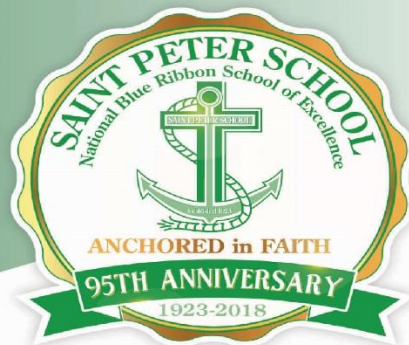

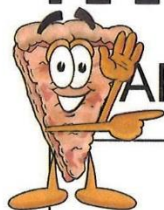
Carnival Day Lunch Order Form

AUSTRALIA



Aboriginal Dot Art
