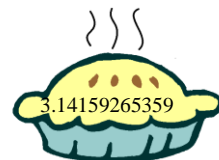
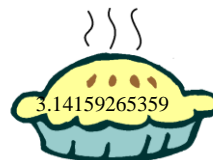
SPS STEM Project – Happy

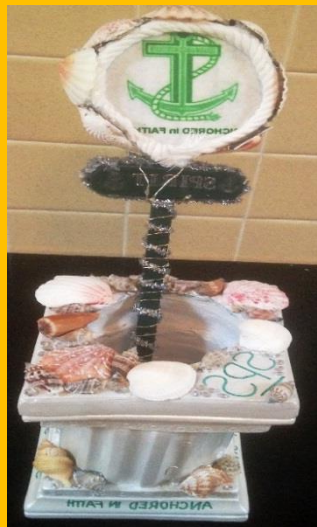

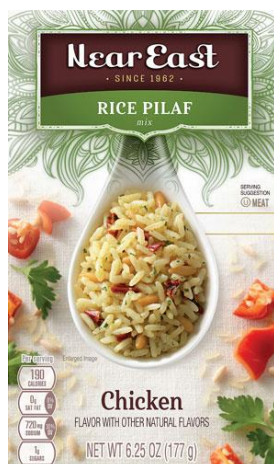

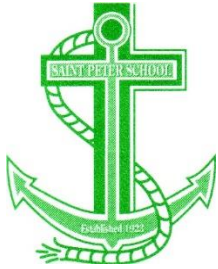
Dear Saint Peter School Families,

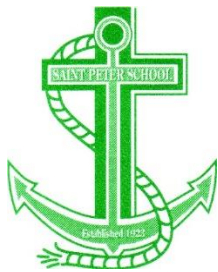

Dear Parents:

With the Iowa Assessment testing week approaching, we are asking that you join us in our mission to prepare the students for a successful testing experience. All year, we have been presenting students with test taking strategies and skills that will help to prepare them, not only for the Iowa Testing, but for many types of tests they will take now and in the future.

Please make sure that your child has a healthy breakfast each morning and sufficient sleep each night. Proper sleep and nutrition are essential components of working to the best of one's ability. In addition, we have prepared the following list of test taking strategies for you to review and utilize with your child at home:

- ✓ Check your work.
- ✓ Eliminate answers that are obviously incorrect.
- ✓ Be sure you are on the correct section, page and question before recording your answer.
- ✓ Read questions before reading the passage to establish a purpose for reading.
- ✓ Read all answer choices before selecting your answer.
- ✓ Don't spend too much time on one question.
- ✓ Answer all questions. Your best guess is always better than no answer.
- ✓ Be aware of key words in the questions (i.e. always, never, not, etc.)
- ✓ Only change your answer if you are sure your first choice is wrong.
- ✓ Read everything and read carefully.

We know that education and your child's success is as important to you as it is to us. We ask you to join us in making sure your child is prepared to "show what they know" each and every day as well as on the Iowa Assessment Tests this year. Please review the above work/test strategies with your child on a regular basis. Together we can help to ensure that these life skills become the good habits your child will need for future success.

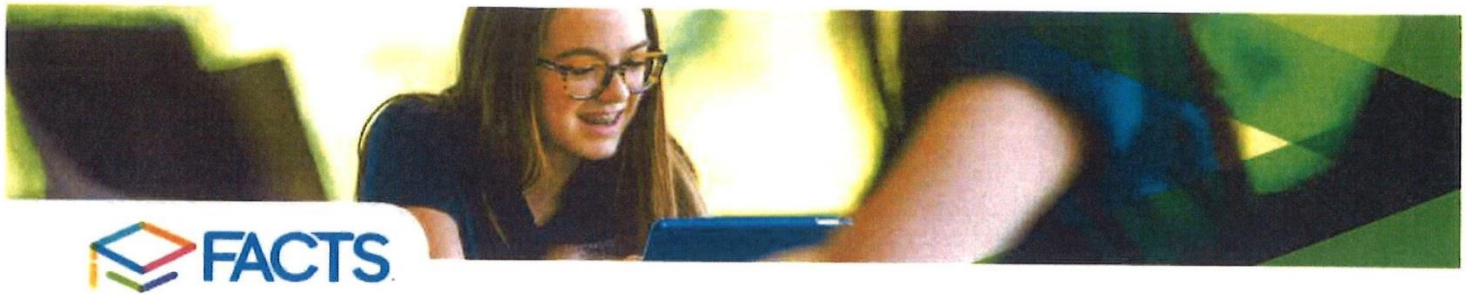

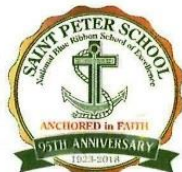
