

A Sneaker Recycling Organization

We all probably have at least one pair of athletic shoes we no longer wear! By giving up your old shoes to an organization like GotSneakers, those shoes are cleaned up and then sent to impoverished areas of the world where they take on a second life.

In places like the Caribbean, Central America, South America, West Africa, and Europe, citizens are in desperate need of footwear. Old shoes can help less fortunate people in these areas avoid disease and gain admission to schools that require the students to have footwear. Plus, this keeps shoes out of landfills where they can take up to 40 years to decompose.

What types of footwear does GotSneakers accept? GotSneakers

accepts all styles of footwear, including new, gently used, used, and unwearable shoes, sneakers, rubber soccer cleats, and rubber baseball cleats.

Shoes in landfills can take 30 to 40 years to decompose.
