Thank you for all your cooperation. We are looking forward to this music filled Christmas get together.





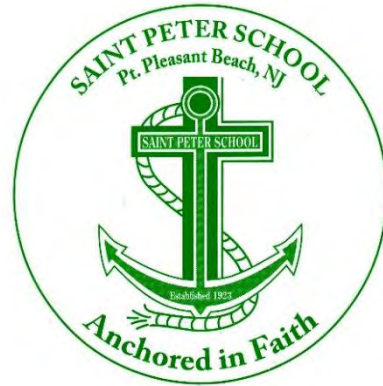
Dear Saint Peter Families,

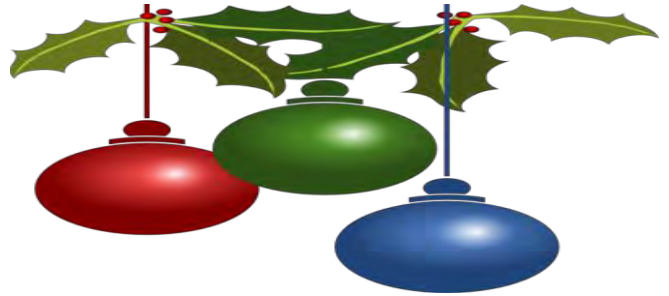

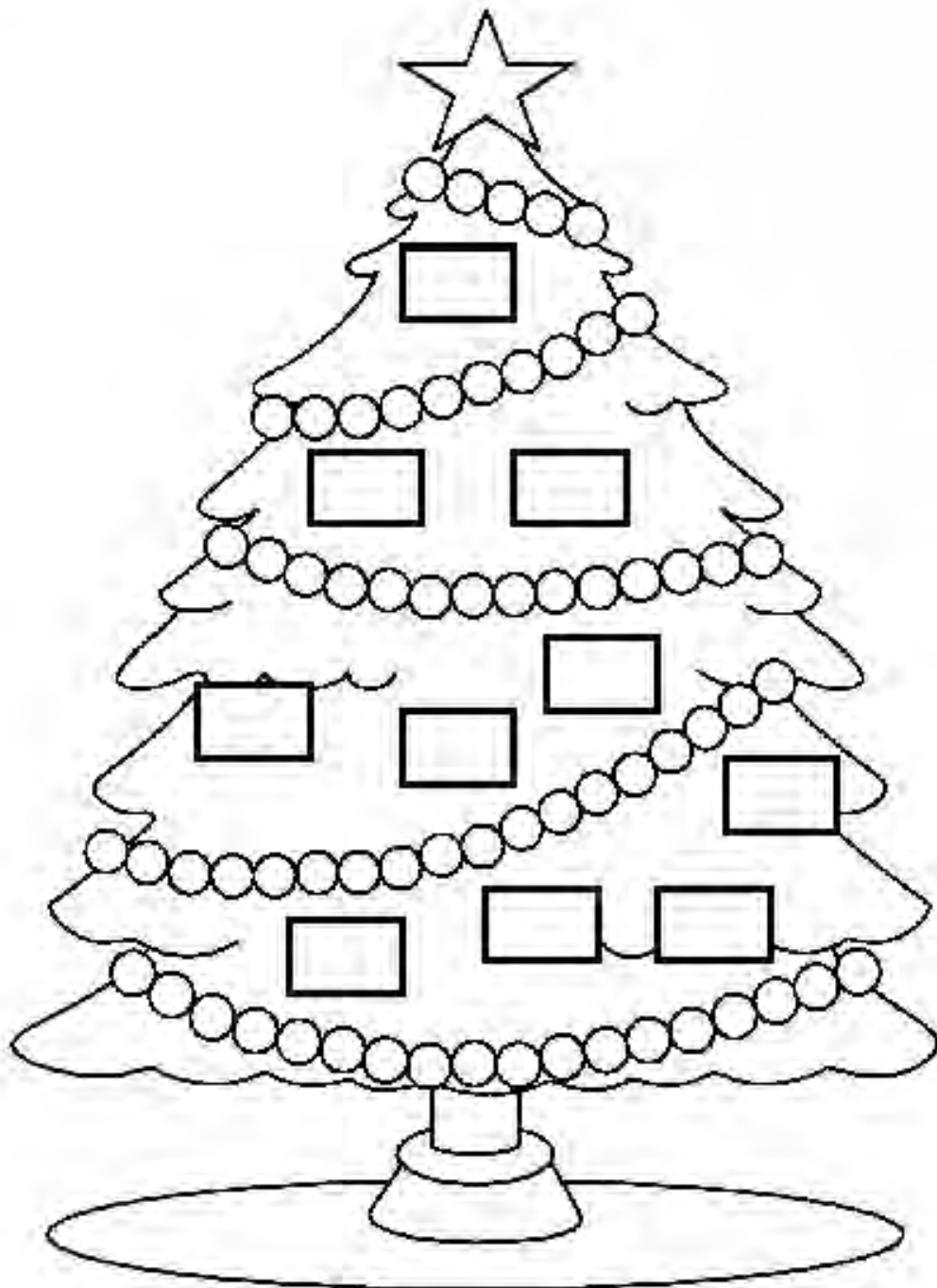
